

**Memorandum of Agreement between
Blackstone Valley Community Health Center and the City of Central Falls**

This Memorandum of Agreement ("Agreement") is entered between the City of Central Falls, Rhode Island ("City") and the Blackstone Valley Community Health Care, Inc ("BVCHC") hereinafter jointly referred to as the ("parties").

WHEREAS, the goals of this agreement are to provide long acting contraception to the students who use the school-based health center at Central Fall High School.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and promises contained herein and intending to be legally and equitably bound hereby, the City and BVCHC agree as follows:

1. The City of Central Falls will make available \$10,000.00 in the 2019-2020 school year for long acting contraception for high school students at Central Falls High School.
2. BVCHC will use the funds only for long acting contraception, and only for students of the school-based health center in Central Falls high school who do not have health insurance that pays for long acting contraception.
3. The City will pay BVCHC \$2,500.00 on signing the agreement, and \$2,500.00 after records are submitted for the first twelve patients, and \$5,000.00 after twenty-five students have been treated.
4. BVCHC will record the date of birth and date of administration for each patient who receives long acting contraception and will submit those records to the Central Falls Office on Health after the first twelve patients have been treated, and then again after twenty-five patients have been treated.
5. The parties agree that by providing this funding, the City is not beginning a doctor – patient relationship nor shall the City be held liable for the provision of this money; BVCHC shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the City from and against any and all costs, damages, expenses, judgments, fines and other amounts of whatsoever nature arising out of this agreement.
6. Blackstone Valley Neighborhood Health Station and the City of Central Falls have the authority to update this Agreement as necessary, in collaboration with all parties and subject to consensus by participating authorities. Any updates or changes will require the signature of each participating entity.
7. This Agreement may be terminated by any party upon issuance of written notice to each other party with sixty days' notice. The 60-day notice may be waived upon mutual written consent of all parties.
