

First Amendment to Memorandum of Understanding

This is a First Amendment to a Memorandum of Understanding dated as of January 30, 2017 (the Agreement) between the Rhode Island Public Transit Authority (RIPTA) and City of Central Falls (Central Falls), both of whom may be referred to collectively as the Parties.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, as of January 30, 2017 the Parties entered into the Agreement, under which the Parties wished to procure the fabrication and installation of three bus shelters at the Landing

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to amend the Agreement as follows:

1. The third WHEREAS clause is amended as follows:

WHEREAS, for the foregoing reasons, the Parties wish to procure the fabrication and installation of two (2) bus shelters for installation in the City of Central Falls (the Project);

2. Sections 4 and 8 of the Agreement are amended to reflect the number of shelters is reduced from three (3) shelters to two (2) shelters.
3. The two (2) shelters will be installed in the following locations: one (1) at the Blackstone River Landing, and one (1) in Quinn Square near the RIC Workforce Development Hub on Dexter Street.
4. Section 10 of the Agreement states that Central Falls shall provide commercial general liability insurance coverage in the amount of \$1,000,000 per occurrence with \$2,000,000 in the annual aggregate. Central Falls shall provide RIPTA with a certificate of insurance for these shelters, along with their locations and shall name RIPTA as an additional insured. The Certificate of Insurance shall be attached to this First Amendment as Exhibit A.
5. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect.
6. This First Amendment represents the final and complete understanding of the Parties regarding the subject matter hereof and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous negotiations and discussions regarding that subject matter. There is no commitment, agreement, or understanding concerning the subject matter of this First Amendment that is not contained in this written document.
