Dear Mr. Vandermillen:

It is our understanding that the City of Central Falls recently received a \$500,000 grant to be used for improving additional roadways that will serve the future train station. The roadways include the following:

- *Watson Street- (Lonsdale Avenue to Pine Street)* – approximately 1,000 feet
- *Rand Street (Lonsdale Avenue to Pine Street)*- approximately 1,100 feet
- *Rand Street (Pine Street to Dexter Street)*-approximately 470 feet
- *Central Street (Pine Street to Dexter Street)* – approximately 500 feet
- *Knight Street (Pine Street to Dexter Street)* – approximately 560 feet
- *Cross Street (Pine Street to Dexter Street)* – approximately 600 feet

Pare Corporation (Pare) is submitting a Contract Addendum (CA) No. 2 for the above-referenced project, as discussed, to obtain approximately twelve (12) pavement cores at the above described street locations. The reason for the cores is to determine the existing pavement thickness for the above referenced streets to aid Pare in confirming if pavement milling and overlay is a viable design improvement alternative for this project. These services will be performed by Thielsch Engineering, Inc. (TEI) and consists of the following work:

- Extract a total of twelve (12) 4-inch diameter full depth asphalt pavement samples by wet core drilling methods at the locations determined by Pare.
- Cores will be brought back to the TEI's office in Cranston, RI laboratory and measured, photographed and catalogued for further examination.
- TEI will repair core holes using a high strength grout or cold patch.
- Pare in association with TEI will prepare a report documenting findings.



In addition, in order to do an opinion of probable cost for the additional roadway work and to provide unit bid measurements for the additional roadway work that is to be added into our existing construction contract, Pare will need to perform a field review of each street to determine the improvements needed and then will add a project description for improvements for each street and develop an approximate quantity takeoff for the necessary improvements. The fee to complete these services will be **Six Thousand Six Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$6,620.00)**. Please note there will be no plan development performed as part of this change order.

Pare trusts that this request is acceptable to the City of Central Falls and we are available to review this Contract Addendum No. 2 with you or members of the City at your convenience. Should you have any questions or comments, please contact me at your convenience.


