## Remember! Do **NOT** place these items in your blue recycling cart:



No food waste or containers still containing liquids, food, other solids or any items covered in oil or grease. Place these in the trash.



LEAF & YARD WASTE

No leaves, twigs, braches, or grass clippings. Leaf & yard waste is collected in brown paper bags on Fridays ONLY, from April-December.



TEXTILES

No clothing, shoes or any other textiles. Drop-off dry, odorless textiles in any clothing donation bin (e.g. Planet Aid), or put in the trash.




No plastic bags or recycling inside plastic bags. To recycle dry, empty plastic bags, place them in the collection boxes at large stores, such as CVS, Walgreens, or Rite Aid. The box is usually located at the store's entrance. BULKY WASTE

No bulky items, e.g. plastic containers larger than 2 gallons, plastic toys and playhouse, shelving, furniture, TVs, computers, small appliances, window blinds, wood. For information about bulky waste disposal call 727-7466.





No scrap metal, knives, broken glass, light bulbs, wires, chains, cables, ropes, or needles. Household Hazardous Waste, like propane tanks and automotive fluids, can be dropped off at an Eco-Depot event: rirrc.org/ecodepot
